The Clinical Director/AED of Clinical Services is responsible for clinical oversight of all agency services, with administrative responsibility for programming including outpatient clinics, children's day treatment, partial hospitalization, and other school-based/community work. The director oversees program quality and outcomes, and champions trainings and initiatives across all service areas. The clinical director is a strategic leader focused on continual process improvement and ensuring that qualified professional staff and consultants provide evidence-based and/or best practices in all licensed disciplines, including but not limited to psychology, social work, and licensed counseling. The director will partner with a variety of stakeholders, including community partners, Local Government Units, and licensing bodies to coordinate and implement trauma-informed services that reflect both cultural competence and align with the agencies values on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion.
